United by the Millennium Development Goals, the global malaria community has worked tirelessly over the past 15 years to save thousands of lives from malaria. Yet malaria is tenacious. It continues to kill more than 600,000 people each year.

The post-MDG global development agenda has a vision for the future that “rests on the core values of human rights, equality and sustainability” and aims for “freedom from want and fear”. In the process of preparing for these goals, the UN is promoting closer integration between different sectors to ensure sustainable development.

So far, the vast majority of global malaria efforts have been primarily focused on direct interventions and partnerships with the health sector. The Swiss Agency for Development and Cooperation and Roll Back Malaria are hosting a meeting on malaria in the “Fishbowl” format look beyond these conventional boundaries.

The **Malaria Fishbowl** will encourage dialogue on how the global malaria community can integrate with non-health sectors to help eliminate malaria and pave the way for sustainable development. It will offer a unique opportunity to discuss effective strategies to integrate with the non-health sector to ultimately free the world of malaria.
